#### 8. **TECHNICAL ACTIVITIES**

## 8.1 Plant Visits

IIM Delhi Chapter regularly organizes plant visits in and around NCR for benefits of its members. In this connection, teams of IIM DC members visited the following plants on 7<sup>th</sup> April 2012 and 7<sup>th</sup> March 2013.

While Hansa Metallics Ltd has in-house facilities for Cold Rolled Steel Strips and foils and high frequency ERQ precision tubes, the other two plants at (b) and (c) above produce aluminium automobile components for automakers. ## 9. Workshop on Ferro Alloys

The Indian Institute of Metals-Delhi Chapter organized a Ferro Alloys Workshop on 1<sup>st</sup> May 2012 at their Chapter premises.

Around forty five representatives participated in the deliberations of the Workshop. They included representatives from Tata Steel, M N Dastur & Co, Mecon, SAIL, Jindal Steel, Steel Furnaces Association, ECI, MOIL, Department of Steel and representatives from various Ferro Alloys Manufacturing Units.

## 10. Seminar on Nano Technology

The IIM-DC organized a Seminar on Nano Technology on 5<sup>th</sup> May 2012 in its auditorium.

The Seminar was attended by about 60 persons. The audience included students pursuing Nano Technology stream, officers from Ministry of Steel, SAIL, MECON, CET, Joint Plant Committee and a few other organizations.

This technology basically involves manipulation of atoms, molecules and materials to form structures on the Nano Scale (billions of a metre). These new structures physically exhibit new properties or behaviour due to quantum mechanics.

Five eminent scientists from different institutes/organizations gave presentations as under:

- 1. Dr. R P Singh, Director, Amity Institute of Nano Technology gave the key-Note address in the Seminar and spoke on "Indian Status of Nano Technology & its Future Perspectives
- 2. Dr. P K Chaudhury, Scientist G & Head Nano Technology Division of Solid State Physics of Ministry of Defence, R & D Organisation spoke on "Carbon Nano based Tube Devices
- 3. Dr. A K Srivastava, Principal Scientist of National Physical Laboratory, gave a presentation on "Materials Characterization at Nano Scale:Importance & Implication"
- 4. Dr. R. Bhattacharyya, Visiting Faculty of Delhi Technological University, spoke on "Metal Nano Particles and the Promise of Plasmanics"
- 5. Dr. O P Sinha of Amity Institute of Nano Technology addressed the gathering on "Role of Nano Technology on Solid State Lighting

The celebration function was inaugurated by Shri S K Roongta, former Chairman SAIL and presently MD of Vedanta. IIM DC participated in these celebrations

## 12. Brahm Prakash Memorial Material Quiz Competition

- 12.1 IIM Delhi chapter organized a Quiz Competition named "Metallica 2012" amongst school students of Delhi on 28<sup>th</sup> January 2012. Over 40 students from various schools participated in the Quiz Contest.
- 12.2 A team of two students from Mount Carmel School, Vasant Vihar, New Delhi was the winner of the Quiz Contest. Manav Sthali School was declared first runner-up and Suraj Bhan Dev Public School was declared second runner-up in the Quiz Competition.
- 12.3 A team of two students from Mount Carmel School along with their accompanying teacher was sponsored for the Brahm Prakash Memorial Material Quiz Competition held at Kalpakkam on 14<sup>th</sup> September 2012.
- 12.4 The to and fro travel expenses of the two students along with the teacher were borne by IIM DC.

## 13. Metals, Minerals, Metallurgy & Materials (MMMM-2012)

- 13.1 The 9<sup>th</sup> edition of Metals, Minerals, Metallurgy & Materials (MMMM-2012) was organized by our Delhi Chapter jointly with the International Trade & Exhibition Events Pvt Ltd from 27<sup>th</sup> 30<sup>th</sup> September 2012 at Pragati Maidan, New Delhi. The event consisted of an industrial exhibition and an International conference on 'Resurgent India-Vision 2020 in Metals and Minerals Sectors'. About 55 technical papers were presented in the conference.
- 13.2 There were two plenary sessions on aluminium, uranium/thorium and raw materials for iron and steel industry and raw materials beneficiation aspects. These two sessions covered raw material security aspects and technological strategies for steel sector and special steels for strategic applications.
- 13.3 Two sessions were devoted to mining and two sessions to business scenario for ferrous and non-ferrous metals industries. There were two sessions on current and futuristic metals and minerals technologies, one session on new material development and applications and one session on energy and environment.
- 13.4 55 papers of International standards, out of which 40 were from doyens of industry and the rest from Exhibitors, were presented in the International Conference. Over 200 delegates from Indian and overseas companies participated in the Conference deliberations.
- 13.5 The conference was inaugurated by Dr. Dalip Singh, Jt. Secretary, Ministry of Steel, Dr. Dalip Singh spoke on the growth plans of Indian Steel Industry and also reviewed the details of the Process Routes for creation of enhanced steel capacity. He also highlighted the R & D efforts of Iron & Steel Sector and invited R & D proposals from the Iron & Steel fraternity to cover different facets of Iron & Steel Production. In his Keynote address, Dr. S K Gupta, Former CMD MECON and Director, JSW Steels emphasized the need for exploring, developing and committing raw materials resources for the targeted growth of steel production of 89 MTPA to 200 MTPA by 2020.
- 13.6 Shri R N Parbat (Past President IIM), Shri P C Gupta (Ex CMD NMDC), Shri M Narayana Rao (CMD MIDHANI & Past President IIM), Shri Y S Kapadia (Ex-MD Lurgi India and Ex-GM Tata Steel), Dr. G Mukherjee (Ex-Vice Chairman SAIL), Dr. L K Singhal, Dr. S K Gupta were Shri G P Kundargi, CMD, MOIL, Shri K K Mehrotra, CMD MECON, Shri S S Mohanty, D (T) SAIL & Vice President IIM, Shri Sushim Banerjee, DG, Institute of Steel Development & Growth, Dr. R K Iyengar, President, Technovation International Inc., were among the distinguished speakers in the Conference.
- 13.7 Post Conference, a report containing summary of the Conference and Recommendations emanating from the Conference was compiled and got printed. Copies of the same were sent to important PSUs and also to the economic ministries of Govt. of India, National Council Members and also to other Chapters of IIM.
- 13.8 The feedback of the Conference was very encouraging. The contents of the technical papers and organization of the Conference were appreciated by various quarters.

## 14. **Conferment of the Best Chapter Award on IIM-Delhi Chapter**

We are happy to inform that the Delhi Chapter has been bestowed Best Chapter Award for overall performance during 2011-12 among large Chapters of IIM. *This is the first time in the history of our Chapter that we have received Best Chapter Award*.
