9.0 MMMM 2016 – MEGA EVENT OF THE CHAPTER

MMMM 2016 was a flagship event of the Chapter. The 11th edition of MMMM event consisting of Exhibition and International Conference was organized by our Delhi Chapter jointly with ITEI from 10th to 12th August 2016 at Pragati Maidan, New Delhi. The Conference was inaugurated by Hon'ble Minister for Steel Chaudhary Birender Singh on 10th August 2016. The valedictory session of the Conference was presided over by Hon'ble Minister of State for Steel, Shri Vishnu Deo Sai.

Dr. Aruna Sharma, Secretary, Ministry of Steel and Shri Balvinder Kumar, Secretary, Ministry of Mines, were the Guests of Honour in the Inaugural Function and Valedictory Session respectively.

After Inaugural Session, the Hon'ble Minister of Steel and Secretary, Ministry of Steel went around the Exhibition Stalls. About 35 countries participated in the Exhibition. Around 300 Exhibitors had put up their stalls in the Exhibition and more than 15,000 trade visitors visited in the three days' Exhibition.
